

GROUP UNPACKS

What is a Group Unpack?

- The purpose of the group unpack session is to offer Victorian Government Secondary schools an alternative to 1:1 interviews where participation may be challenging
- A Group Unpack provides students with a demonstration on how to interpret and understand their Morrisby Profile and learn the interactive features
- A group unpack is interactive, and students can be supported by staff, peers, and the MCI team in a small setting of 8-27 students.

Unpack Day: How will this look?

- MCI staff will visit your school and give a presentation on understanding the Morrisby profile. There will be opportunities for interaction with students and to answer individual questions
- Students will log in to their profile during the session
- Students will gain a deeper understanding of their Morrisby profile and be guided through functionality for future use
- Students will complete a worksheet during the Group Unpack
- The structure of the day will depend on your cohort number and school timetable. It is preferable to run consecutive sessions on the same day
- Each session will run for a minimum of 45-60 minutes.



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Things to Consider

- The “Getting Prepared Presentation” has been delivered to students
- Ensure all students have a completed profile - this may be a full profile, optional aptitudes or Morrisby careers profile
- Ensure students can access their profile before the Group Unpack session. If required, generate recovery codes for students who are unable to open their profile
- Students should have an IT device to access their profile during the Group Unpack
- Students may have their 4-page short report printed and available during the unpack session
- Room set-up requirements: This needs to be large enough for an interactive presentation – a large classroom is recommended.
